

ACP Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)?


- The ACP is a new long-term program that will replaced the EBB program effectice 12/31/21 under the new Infrastructure Act.
- Astrea is a participant in the ACP which offers financial aid in the form of bill credits up to \$30/mo for eligible households (up to \$75/mo on Tribal Land).
 - The \$30 credit will begin 1/1/22 for new enrollees, or 3/1/22 for households that were enrolled through the EBB Program as of 12/31/21. Those who were enolled in the EBB program will received credits up to \$50 per month in January and February 2022.
- The ACP credit is portable, meaning even if you are enrolled for EBB or ACP through another provider, that benefit can be transferred to Astrea at any time.

What benefits are available through Astrea?

- Astrea customers enrolled in the EBB Program can receive monthly bill credits
- Enrollees can also visit astrea.pcsrefurbished.com to browse heavily discounted laptops and other devices (the maximum price is \$49.99) and purchase 1 per household
