While the technical skills for a small migration may be somewhat standard and stock within a corporation, concerning a large-scale migration program, it is likely that this type of mass change is well beyond the norm for most organizations to execute successfully.

In most organizations, a transformation of this extent is an extremely infrequent occurrence, rarely providing internal resources with the opportunity to become competent and efficient at such a specialized transformation.

02 Planning & Coordination
