Has RITA improved the management of falls?	Yes! Our residents are spending more time around the RITA, familiarising themselves with the 'new toy'. Due to the curiosity of RITA, this is distracting the residents from becoming bored and wandering around looking for something to do. Thus, potentially leading to falls.
Has RITA improved the prevention in hospital admission?	Yes, RITA provides joy to the residents as they're drawn-in to the activities that RITA has to offer. By RITA providing meaningful and safe choices to the residents, they're less likely to put themselves in harms way which could result in a hospital admission.
Has RITA improved mental health and stimulation?	The residents can play games and choose what music they want to listen to. This is brilliant to witness as the residents can make independent choices about what music and games they want to select. So not only are they improving their mental health through the enjoyment of being able to make their own choices they are also having fun.
Has incidences of behaviours that challenge reduced?	We have one gentleman who has grown very fond of RITA. Since we've introduced him to the system, his behaviour has improved a lot.
Has RITA improved residents engaging in group work activities?	We have seen a big improvement with group work. Residents are now watching a film together and listening to music of their own, independent choices. We've seen improvements where the residents are chatting more to each other as they're engaging in the same activities which gives them a topic in common to trigger conversation.
Has RITA created a calmer environment and improved wellbeing?	All round, we've noticed a much nicer, calmer atmosphere. The residents are happy and enjoying the activities that RITA has to offer. Residents have started to sit closer to each other in comparison to how they were prior to RITA arriving.
