What a week we've had with the patients all enjoying and exploring what's on there. I came down to the day room earlier today to find the 2 of the men singing along to 'The Old Rugged Cross' with the other patients & staff having a good old chuckle at them!!

They've done quizzes and enjoyed listening to the relaxation music on there. A small group of ladies played a game of mah-jong. It's a real conversation starter and they are all so keen to 'have a go'!

Other patients have enjoyed just browsing and reading bits on the tablet too.

We've sourced a new TV for the wall so we plan to have a link up of RITA to the large TV Screen.
