The Willows Residential Care Home is situated close to Cleveleys Town Centre and run by Lancashire County Council. The Willows is registered for a maximum of 6 people who have learning disabilities aged between 18-45, and offers person centered care to its residents 24/7. The Specialist Care Categories are Autism/ASD, Epilepsy, Speech Impairment, Hearing Impairment & Deafness. The home. There are two floors of the home available for residents and it comprises of four single and one double room. En-suite facilities are provided and in addition, bathrooms are available on both floors.
