Have falls decreased since the introduction of RITA?	Yes! We have only been utilising RITA for 1 month and we can already identify a reduction in our falls.
Has RITA improved the management of falls?	RITA provides us with a quick, easy and risk-free tool to be able to engage and distract residents at times when we identify potential fall risks.
Has RITA prevented hospital admissions?	Yes! Due to residents being occupied and engaging in person cantered activities, they are less likely to become bored and potentially put themselves in risky situations that could lead to hospital admissions.
Has RITA improved mental health and stimulation after residents have returned from hospital/medical treatment?	We have seen really positive results in this area and RITA has been really effective. We have been able to reduce sundowning, residents walking with purpose and agitation when residents return to our service.
Has the amount of challenging behaviours reduced since RITA was introduced?	Residents definitely seem more content and relaxed since we received RITA and the challenging behaviours previously reported, have certainly reduced.
Has RITA improved residents engaging in group work activity?	This is another area that we have seen a significant improvement in. All residents now seem to chat and engage with one another more, improving their social skills and mental health.
Has medication, PRN's reduced since RITA was introduced?	Yes! Due to residents seeming a lot happier, calmer and distracted in meaningful activities, there hasn't been as much of a requirement for PRN medication.
