Has RITA improved mental health and stimulation?	RITA is a great tool for residents to engage in 1-1 activities whilst confined to their bedrooms for medical reasons, due to its portability.  We also have one resident who is nursed in bed throughout the day. RITA has been excellent because we've been able to do more personcentred sessions with her and keep her from feeling isolated from the other residents.
Have incidences of challenging behaviours reduced since RITA was introduced?	A few residents in particular have enjoyed the films and would otherwise present with challenging behaviour.
Has RITA improved residents engaging in group work activity?	RITA has generated a lot of conversation opportunities and lots of giggles.
	Group activities have improved and we now offer more constructive stimulation to keep the residents engaged.
