# Making sense of the new GP contract 2022/23



On 1st March, NHSEI issued a letter outlining details on the new GP contract which comes into effect on 1st April. We have stripped this down to help you understand what it means for your practice.

#### General

ICB's	CCGs are being replaced by Integrated Care Boards (ICBs) from April who will take over responsibility for commissioning primary care services.

# **Funding**

QOF	<ul> <li>QOF income protection comes to an end at the end of this month*.</li> <li>NHSEI is committed to honouring the existing 5 year funding deal, which is due to run until 23/24.</li> </ul>
IIF	<ul> <li>Limited expansion of the cardiovascular disease and prevention and diagnosis service, and the anticipatory care and personalised care services</li> <li>Three new IIF indicators focused on DOAC prescribing (over 70% of AF patients need to be on them)</li> <li>New indicator for FIT testing for cancer referrals (performed between 7 days before to 14 days after the referral to attract additional funding)</li> </ul>

### Access

Capacity	<ul> <li>PCN budget to recruit additional staff increased by £280m to over £1b for 22/23.</li> <li>PCN's continue to have flexibility to hire into any of 15 different roles.</li> <li>Doubling of mental health practitioner roles, to support patients with complex mental health needs.</li> </ul>
Out of hours	<ul> <li>Extended Access and GP Access combined into 'Enhanced Access' and being managed by PCNs from Oct '22.</li> <li>Bookable appointments 6:30-8pm weekday evenings and 9am-5pm on Saturdays.</li> <li>PCN's expected to come up with local plan for their own area. Draft plans due 31st Jul, final iteration agreed by 31st Aug.</li> </ul>
Bookings	<ul> <li>Online appointment booking - currently at least 25% of appointments must be available for online booking.</li> <li>In the new contract, "all appointments which do not require triage are able to be booked online, as well as in person or via the telephone".</li> </ul>

#### **Data**

Subject Access requests	<ul> <li>Subject Access Requests to continue.</li> <li>Continuation of funding in Global Sum of £20m for one additional year.</li> <li>This is relevant to 'accelerated access' or 'prospective access' which come into effect in April (delayed from December) and have a big impact on subject access requests / data access.</li> </ul>
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### Other

New patients	'Modernisation of GP registration', allowing patients to register digitally. No details yet.
Imms	• Minor changes to vaccinations and imms, which reflect updates to the vaccination schedule recommended by the JCVI.
