Blueprint Practice Exams

We have found that the students that have the largest score increases tend to complete **2,500** test questions through a combination of practice exams and Qbank questions. As such, we set a goal for you to complete **8 Blueprint Practice Exams** and **1,700 practice questions in** your Blueprint account. It is also imperative that you review content using a combination of the learning modules, live lectures, and your strategy book.

Each class lesson will have pre-class modules and post-class quizzes assigned. Generally, you can expect to spend around **10-15** hours per week outside of class per lesson. If you are taking a once a week class, your total time commitment will be around **12-18** hours each week for LSAT prep, but for a twice a week class, it will be closer to **25-30** hours per week. Classes that alternate between meeting once and twice a week will require on average **15-20** hours per week.

# Plan to spend

10-15 Hours per week outside of class per lesson

#### Mastering the LSAT takes more

work than most test-takers initially realize. We designed this course to cover all the key concepts and material you'll need for test day, with extra focus on more common test material. The assigned homework accounts for roughly 45% of the total 2,500 question goal. The 5 assigned practice tests and the addition of 3 tests broken into individual sections for extra timed practice in your final weeks will be about 30%. The remaining 25% of your practice should be self-directed, since only you know the areas you need more practice on. You should build numerous small Qbank sets that target material you need to work on, focusing first on untimed practice to build your accuracy. Later in your prep you'll hone your timing, anticipation, and smart guessing skills.

This table outlines how you can accomplish these goals as you work through the 15 lessons of the course. The running totals show how many modules and questions you should have completed after working through all of the coursework (prework and test questions) for each lesson.

# **Final Prep**

In the final month of your prep, in addition to a full practice test once a week, you should do individual timed sections of a practice test multiple times per week. These 12 timed sections are not assigned to a specific lesson but rather grouped with the final practice test in the end of course row, because depending on your test date they could overlap with the lessons or come after the end of your course. A good way to structure these weeks is to split your days into fast and slow practice days. On the fast days you can do two timed sections, reviewing and setting priorities after each one. On the slow days you'll want to focus on your areas of weakness: review the fundamental strategies then do small sets of material, focusing on updating your strategy for that type of material based on what you discovered led to your errors in your timed work. The next fast day you'll work on incorporating those changes into your timed work. This cycle of fast practice, review, and slow refinement will provide the polish you need to both accuracy and timing in the final weeks.
