



## Maintenance Recommendation

WEINMANN Emergency Medical Technology GmbH + Co. KG, an established and reputable manufacturer of medical equipment, with a registered office and place of business at Frohbösestraße 12, 22525 Hamburg, Germany and a factory known as the “Center for Production, Logistics, Service” at Siebenstücken 14, 24558 Henstedt-Ulzburg, Germany, hereby strongly advises its customers to perform maintenance on the medical equipment they purchase in accordance with the service intervals defined in the Instructions for Use.

If medical equipment is not properly maintained, this can lead to life-threatening situations. In order to minimize the risk of an unpredictable failure or malfunction that may put patients in jeopardy, WEINMANN Emergency strongly recommends regular maintenance. Complying with this recommendation helps to avoid legal risks that arise for both the user and his organization when operating inadequately maintained medical equipment.

Maintenance of WEINMANN Emergency medical equipment involves the replacement and adjustment of critical parts that wear out after a certain amount of time or after extensive use, the performance of recommended updates and the performance of a comprehensive safety inspection. Performing this maintenance regularly at the intervals defined

in the Instructions for Use is the only way to ensure the optimal level of performance and to ensure that safety and reliability are achieved. For WEINMANN Emergency products, this interval is typically defined as every two years.

Due to the complexity of WEINMANN Emergency medical equipment, only WEINMANN Emergency or an officially trained and authorized WEINMANN Emergency Service Partner should perform the aforementioned maintenance activities. WEINMANN Emergency Service Partners meet multiple requirements. These include training and qualifying their employees at in-depth service trainings, as well as providing the necessary special testing and measuring instruments and the required special tools.
