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Session 1

Dazzling Designers Battle! This video will give your class an overview of the Digital Design industry as you watch professional product designer Ben Skinner and his son Lukas battle to see who can design the best surfboard!

Key Language: Graphic Design, Digital Design, Computer Programme

Design a Logo

Design a new logo for your school/favourite brand/made up business. Think about what needs to go in the logo (perhaps the school/brands name). Think about what is important to the brand (e.g. if it is an eco-friendly brand, how can you show that?). Think about what the brand represents (e.g. if it is a sports brand, how will people know?).

You can design your logo on paper or on a computer programme such as Tate Paint https://www.tate.org.uk/kids/games-quizzes/tate-paint

Session 2

Workplace Tour- This video goes into more detail of the specific roles in a Digital Design company. You will see employees and the equipment they use.

Introducing SkinDog- The surfboard design company! In their offices and warehouse down in Newquay, Cornwall, SkinDog design their own surfboards, from the shape of the board to the graphics and logos that decorate them, everything is designed using a computer.

Follow a Design Specification

Create a Design Spec for your friend to follow. Imagine you are putting on an event (this could be a sporting event, such as surf, skate, football or dance competition or a concert). You need a graphic designer to make a poster to promote the event. Write a design spec for your friend to follow.

What images do you want on there?

What information (writing) do you want on there? What style would you like it (bright and colourful, bold, classy)?

Swap design specs with a friend and see if you can design their poster for them following their design spec.

Design a Product

Design a new piece of sporting equipment- this could be a surfboard or football, some dance shoes or boxing gloves. Think about the shape and material of the product- does it need to be able to glide through water easily or be made of protective material? Label your design. What sort of colours/shapes/symbols will you decorate your product with and why? Do you want your product to represent a fierce athlete or a relaxed beach atmosphere- what colours would you choose?
