

BAND: RAISE (1)
Suitable for students in Primary One

In Term 1, students will learn commonly confused phonics concepts to aid in reading fluency and spelling. They will also learn about the parts of speech to help them with grammar components. For listening and comprehension, they will learn to visualise to enhance understanding. They will also learn to identify question words and answer literal questions.

For writing, they will learn to edit for punctuation. They will also learn the parts of a basic sentence, as well as how to construct sentences.
