- □ Always perform regular inspections and maintenance on mounts and related hardware.




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I. Removal of OEM Grille Note: Save all OEM parts until installation is complete.

A. Remove the push pin retainers and remove the air deflector.




B. NOTE: As truck is equipped, disconnect the electrical connectors and washer hose.




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C. Note for vehicles equipped with fender mouldings: Remove the 2 screws and release the 3 front fender moulding retainers and position the fender moulding out.





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
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D. Remove the headlamp trim panel screws and pushpins.



E. Remove the pin-type retainer.





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
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Installation Instructions Adaptive Cruise Control Relocation Bracket

Application: 2017+ Ford SKU:M3850

- F. Remove the headlamp assembly trim panel.
 - A. Remove the pin-type retainer.
 - **B.** Starting at the inner edge, release the headlamp assembly trim panel clips.
 - C. Starting at the outer edge, release the headlamp assembly trim panel.
 - **D.** Using a flat-blade screwdriver release the locking tabs and remove the headlamp trim panel.




G. Remove the air deflector from the grille on both sides.



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
H. Remove the upper screws.



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



- I. Remove the screw on the right-hand and left-hand side.
 - A. Pull up to disengage the locating pins along the top of the grille.
 - **B.** Pull forward on center of the grill to remove.



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
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II. Bracket Installation

A. Remove four 10 mm bolts from each corner of the backside of grille and one bolt from center behind logo.



B. Using 10mm socket, remove stamped nuts at the bottom of the grille.



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
- C. Separate grille from louvers.
- **D.** Cut internal protrusions of the grille as indicated below.



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E. Position radar bracket on louver frame and mark holes 7/8" from center of louvers. Keeping back tangent with lip of frame.



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


- F. Drill holes using 3/8" bit.
- G. Then using stainless hardware push bolt through bottom of louver frame and tighten radar bracket to louver frame.
- H. Install radar device into radar bracket using two provided M8 nuts.
- I. Adjusting bracket to make perpendicular as possible to bottom of louver frame.



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J. Reinstall grille by reversing the removal process.



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


III. Maintenance/Care

- □ Periodically check and tighten all fasteners.
- □ Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.
- After washing of the vehicle make sure to fully dry all surfaces
