



CREATING AN APPLE DEVELOPER ACCOUNT

An Apple Developer account is required in order to host your Branded app in the store. Follow these easy steps to walk through enrolling in the Apple Developer Program. This process takes just minutes and once you've completed, we will begin developing and managing your app, keeping it updated and functioning properly. First, visit the Apple ID page at <https://appleid.apple.com>.

IMPORTANT:

Before beginning the enrollment process for an Apple Developer account, make sure you know the DUNS number of your organization, and the legal entity name associated with it. If your organization does not have a DUNS number assigned, but your organization is part of a district or organizational headquarters that does have an assigned DUNS number, your district or headquarters will need to set up the Apple Developer account for you.

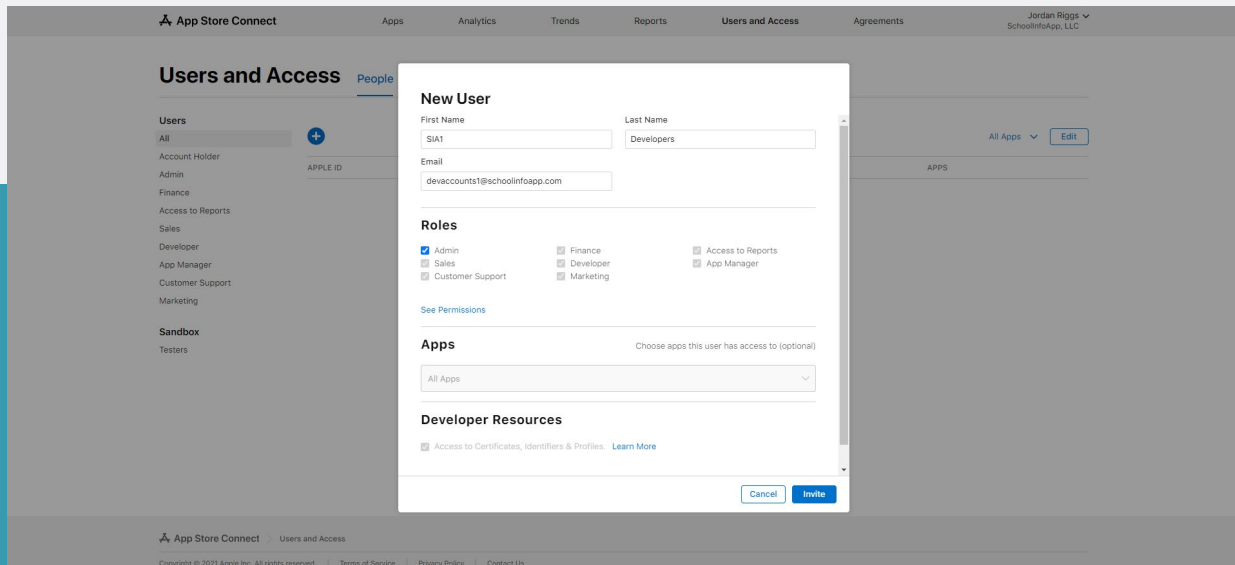
Two-Factor Authentication is different than Two-Step Verification. Please make sure you have enabled Two-Factor Authentication for this new account.

Now that you have completed setting up your Apple ID and have turned on Two-Factor Authentication, you may start the enrollment process for a Developer Account. Visit <https://developer.apple.com/programs/enroll/>. After you complete the enrollment forms, a representative from Apple will call and/or email you to verify your enrollment information and continue the enrollment process.

Once Apple has approved your enrollment and the process is complete, please invite our admin team as an Admin to the Apple Developer account. This is necessary for us to keep your app up-to-date and functioning properly.

To add us, navigate to the “Users and Access” section of App Store Connect, then:

1. Click the “+” symbol next to “Users”.
2. Under the First Name and Last Name fields, fill in “SIA1 Developers”.
3. Under Email, please use the email address of devaccounts1@schoolinfoapp.com.
4. Select the “Admin” role.
5. Under the Developer Resources check the box for “Access to Certificates, Identifiers & Profiles”.
6. Click “Invite”.
