Principal Accountabilities and tasks

- Lead in ensuring that H&S targets and standards are maintained by:
 - Knowing what excellence looks like and communicating H&S with passion and credibility, in order to inspire, motivate and lead the business to achieve the vision;
 - Fostering a continuous improvement culture by actively seeking input from all employees of the company and encouraging them to implement H&S improvements
- Develop and implement a Health and Safety Management System for a new manufacturing site producing heavy duty hydrogen vehicles
- Manage Arcola Energy's H&S team covering activities at other sites
- Take a leading role with other senior team members in developing and embedding business strategy;
- Take a leading role with other senior team members in developing excellent working relationships to improve performance and service to the customer;
- Lead, develop and coach individuals to build a high performing team and create a pipeline of talent;
- Ensure that the business Health and Safety Management System is understood and complied with by all staff;
- Provide advice, support and direction to members of the H&S team to enable them to support the wider business in a coherent and coordinated manner;
- Lead the H&S team in undertaking site engagement tours and inspections and audits of H&S to ensure compliance with the requirements of the H&S Management System;
- Develop and deliver suitable H&S training programmes for all employees (including routine contract inductions) in line with budget;
- Provide support and management of external audits and liaise to assist in the provision of corrective actions and closeout of audit findings;

- Provide feedback on the efficacy of the Safety Management System and make recommendations for improvement;
- Lead the team in identifying the H&S competencies/certification required for staff and ensure these are delivered and maintained.

- Lead on the reviewing and advising on Method Statements and Risk Assessments both internally and from the Supply Chain;
- Undertake the lead role on behalf of the company in communicating with relevant Enforcing Authorities;
- Contribute to internal and External working groups; and
- Support the delivery of the business' Sustainability activities.
